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### MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

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23 Minutes of the March 15, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Chair Mikael Remington  
24 made a **motion** to approve the minutes as written. Mark Oligschlaeger seconded the motion, which  
25 was passed by unanimous vote (4-0).  
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### UPDATE FROM STEVE THACKER ON COUNCIL PLAN TO ADDRESS HILLSIDE ISSUES

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30 Steve Thacker, City Manager, was unable to attend the meeting, and the Committee will  
31 schedule another time to meet with him. Mr. Thacker left copies of a timeline that Cory Snyder,  
32 Community Development Director, presented to the City Council on the management plan for the  
33 foothill property. Robyn Mecham, City Council Liaison, reported the City Council is trying to hire  
34 an intern to work on the hillside issues to move the trail planning process faster. Currently, a  
35 drainage study is being done on the hillside, and must be completed before the trails can be  
36 planned. There is a federal grant that is specific for trails and ATV areas that the City may apply  
37 for. At a future date, an ADHOC committee could be formed to help with fundraising efforts.  
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### VOLUNTEER PROJECTS FOLLOW UP

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41 Chair Remington reported Rick Turner has been working diligently on volunteer projects.  
42 Several Eagle Scout projects are in the process of being completed. Bruce Cox, Parks and  
43 Recreation Director, reported he has an Eagle Scout Project at the bowl area that would be the  
44 installation of fiberglass signs marking the bowl boundaries.

1 Mr. Turner has been overseeing projects at the Freedom Hills Park that include the  
2 installation of three benches, installation of erosion prevention bars on the trail, and the repair of  
3 nine erosion bars. Another project this Saturday will be the installation of more erosion prevention  
4 bars. The trails have also been cleaned and cleared of debris by volunteers.

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6 **GOLDEN SPOKE RIDES AND EVENT**  
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8 Mr. Cox distributed a flyer advertising the Golden Spoke Bike Ride to be held on June 2<sup>nd</sup>.  
9 This event is to celebrate the completion of 100 miles of connecting bike trails that now run  
10 continuous from Bridal Veil Falls to Rainbow Gardens. There will be two rides starting at the same  
11 time from Rainbow Gardens in Ogden Canyon and Bridal Veil Falls in Provo Canyon. The two  
12 groups will meet together at the Jordan River Bridge at about 1:15 pm. A celebration of the bike  
13 trail completion will be held at the Fisher Mansion in Salt Lake starting at 12:30 pm. This event is  
14 free to everyone and a family-friendly event.

16 **OTHER BUSINESS**  
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18 Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported the Active Transportation Grant has  
19 been received. This is for a transportation plan for Bountiful, Centerville, and North Salt Lake.  
20 The next step will be the bidding for the planning companies who want to do the master plan.

22 Matt Johnson would like the City Council to consider RAP Tax funding for Trails Projects  
23 in the next fiscal year that begins in July.
