MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL

23 Minutes of the April 19, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Chair Mark Oligschlaeger made a
24 **motion** to approve the minutes as written. Matt Johnson seconded the motion, which was passed
25 by unanimous vote (5-0).

REPORT ON VOLUNTEER PROJECTS

29 Rick Turner reported he has been having meetings with Boy Scouts who wish to complete
30 their Eagle Scout projects. Josh Ditto and Luke Timeric are currently working on placing erosion
31 timbers and rocks on the Freedom Hills Trail, so that water is moved to the side of the trail to
32 prevent erosion. Jeff Anderson made a bench for the Freedom Hills Switchback Trail. There are
33 30 to 50 other projects that could be completed on trails.

35 Rick Turner found a squatter's camp at the bottom of the canyon off of Johnson's Overlook.
36 He did not approach the camp but believes the Forest Service or police should be notified.

JULY 4TH BOOTH PLANS AND ASSIGNMENTS

40 Chair Remington reported July 4th is on a Wednesday this year. Volunteer assignments will
41 be made at the next meeting. Sunny Larson will be asked to show her video on mountain biking,
42 and Davis County Trail Maps will be given away at the booth. Chair Remington also suggested
43 selling LED lights at the booth for bikers and walkers, so they can be seen better at night. Matt
44 Johnson will follow on the cost of LED lights. Robyn Mecham, City Council Liaison, will see if
45 there is donation money available for the lights.

1 **MAIN STREET STRIPING RECOMMENDATIONS**
2

3 Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, displayed an aerial map of Main Street from
4 Pages Lane to 1350 North. UDOT will be redoing Main Street next year, and the restriping will be
5 changed. Mr. Cox met with Kevin Campbell, City Engineer, and Police Chief Child who
6 recommend a center turning lane on Main Street. The travel lanes will be narrowed to ten feet, the
7 turning lane will be eleven feet, and the bike lane will be seven feet. Mark Oligschlaeger talked
8 about the Active Transportation Grant with North Salt Lake, and Bountiful. Main Street is a main
9 arterial road, and he suggested talking with the individuals who oversee the Active Transportation
10 Plan to see what their recommendations are of the proposed striping. Mr. Oligschlaeger
11 recommended parking not be allowed, or a designated green bike lane be striped on Main Street.

13 **CITY COUNCIL UPDATE ON HILLSIDE DRAINAGE**

15 Robyn Mecham, City Council Liaison, was not able to get her computer to work to give a
16 report on the hillside drainage. She will email her report to Committee members when she is able
17 to get the information. The City Council is trying to hire an intern to move the Hillside Drainage
18 Project along faster. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, reported a young man has been at
19 the trail each Saturday doing a survey of people who are on the trail on what improvements they
20 would like to see on the hillside. The RAP Tax money is gone for this year. Mark Oligschlaeger
21 reported Davis County has money they can put towards this project, and if the County sees a
22 willingness from the City to do this project, they will usually match funds.

24 **OTHER BUSINESS**

26 The Golden Spoke Bike Ride will be held on June 2nd on the Legacy Trail. North Salt Lake
27 and other cities along the Legacy Trail will be have a fair at a park, and trail maps will be given
28 away at this event. Centerville's Trail Committee would like to help with this event, and Brandon
29 Frederico will be asked to help. Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, will get more trail maps
30 printed.

32 Chair Remington would like to take Steve Thacker and Randy Randall up Farmington
33 Canyon to show them the road base they have placed, which the Trails Committee would like to
34 use on the 100 South Trailhead up to the Gun Range.
