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21 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

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23 Minutes of the January 17, 2019 meeting were reviewed. Mark Oligschlaeger made a

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29 Councilwoman Robyn Mecham explained there may be changes in the future to the bike  
30 trail on the hillside, so the UORG grant will not be approved at this time. Once the grant is  
31 submitted, the project cannot be changed, or the grant will be rejected and it cannot be applied for  
32 again. There are still drainage issues that need to be resolved before the trails are completed. In  
33 the meantime, the Trails Committee will focus on the Transportation Plan, and planning races and  
34 trail maintenance activities.

46 repair station and restrooms.

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5                   **OTHER**


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7                   The Committee discussed organizing a 5k and trail maintenance activities this year. This

9 media groups would be helpful to get more participation for a trail run and maintenance activities.


