20 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

22 Minutes of the September 28, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Matt Larsen made a **motion**
23 to approve the minutes as amended. Brent Christison seconded the motion, which was passed by
24 unanimous vote (5-0).

26 **HOME TOUR**

28 The Landmarks Commission commented on the news article in *The Davis Clipper* from
29 last week of the Centerville Historic Home Tour in September. The article also had a picture of
30 Commission member Jeanne Randall at the DUP cabin.

32 **WINTER EVENT AND FUNDRAISER**

34 Cassie Younger, Assistant Planner, explained the Landmarks Commission presents an
35 annual award to honor someone who has been active in historic preservation in the community at
36 the winter event. Brian Plummer was unable to attend the meeting, but he sent an email suggesting
37 a sundae bar for the winter fundraiser.

41 Vivian Talbot suggested honoring Royce Allen, who has written several books about
42 Centerville's history. Brent Christison suggested Vivian Talbot be honored for her many years of
43 service on the Landmarks Commission. Howard and Gabrielle Sain who live in the Streeper home
44 on Main Street in north Centerville were also mentioned as possible candidates to be honored.
45 Cassie Younger will verify who has been honored in the past, and Commission members should
46 provide any additional names to Cassie.

1 **DEUEL CREEK HISTORIC DISTRICT SIGN**

3 Brian Plummer suggested in his email that perhaps a new approach should be taken to
4 solicit donations for the historic district sign. He suggested drafting a letter stating the ideas of the
5 Commission, and take it to the local businesses within the Deuel Creek Historic District requesting
6 their support for the sign. A small plaque on the sign could be placed stating the names of those
7 businesses and individuals who helped sponsor the sign. A luncheon or event could be held
8 honoring the sponsors. Cassie Younger also suggested a light dinner could be held, with a silent
9 auction after from items and gift certificates donated from local businesses. She also suggested
10 doing a Haunted Historic Home Tour next year, and tell stories about the people who used to live
11 in the homes.

13 At 7:37 p.m., Stephanie Ivie, City Council Liaison, arrived at the meeting.

15 The Commission tentatively chose February 20, 2019 as the date for the dinner and silent
16 auction at City Hall. Commission members will communicate through email on businesses they
17 plan to solicit. Brian Plummer will be asked to provide a caterer for this event.

19 **MISCELLANEOUS**




