21 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

23 Minutes of the May 15, 2019 meeting were reviewed. Gary Woodward made a **motion** to

25 unanimous vote (4-0).

27 Mackenzie Wood gave a copy of an email that was sent from Kent Larson of the Centerville  
28 Commons HOA Board located at the corner of Pages Lane and Main Street. He said their flowering  
29 pear trees are aging and have fire blight. The HOA is looking for a long term solution to their tree  
30 issue. Mr. Kent is interested in receiving information on the kinds of trees that grow best in  
31 Centerville, and that could be planted in their neighborhood. Mackenzie Wood will send Mr. Kent  
32 a list of appropriate trees to plant in response to his email.

36 **TREE ORDINANCE: CONTINUE DETAILED REVIEW OF CURRENT**  
37 **ORDINANCE**

39 The Tree Board reviewed the current Tree Ordinance beginning at Section 11. The tree list  
40 will be updated, and then the Board will work on the enforcement section last. The Board discussed  
41 the variety of trees that could be planted in park strips. They are: ivory pillar, narrow trunk maples,  
42 single trunk stem berry, small newport, service berry, honey locusts, mayday, Canadian red (single  
43 trunk), small zelcovah, and green vase.


