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20 **BANK OF AMERICA – CONCEPTUAL SITE PLAN**

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22 Orlando Taylor, representing Bank of America, presented a Conceptual Site Plan for a  
23 new Bank of America building at 782 West Parrish Lane, and answered questions from the  
24 Board. The Board discussed the possible impact on the property of planned expansion of the  
25 Parrish Lane/Market Place Drive intersection and future rebuild of the Parrish Lane interchange.  
26 Eric Malmberg, representing Bank of America, said he would reach out to UDOT and City  
27 Engineer Kevin Campbell.

29 Responding to a question from Mr. Taylor, Brant Hanson, RDA Executive Director and  
30 City Manager, explained that demolition permit and building permit would be issued at the same  
31 time. Director Ince suggested that shifting the building location to the west would allow  
32 landscaping along Market Place Drive.



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36 Bruce Cox, Parks and Recreation Director, explained problems with a boiler at  
37 CenterPoint Theatre, and presented a proposal from American Mechanical Systems Service,  
38 LLC for replacement of the boiler and improvement of the system.

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40 Director McEwan moved to approve the proposal submitted by American Mechanical  
41 Systems Service, LLC for replacement of the CenterPoint Theatre boiler #2 in the amount of  
42 \$120,865.22. Director Ince seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous vote (5-0).
