Centerville Resident,

As a Centerville resident living on Main Street or Pages Lane, we wanted to take a minute to advise you of the upcoming Tour of Utah, and its impact on the road access to your home on **Thursday, August 9, 2018**, sometime **between 12:45 pm and 2:35 pm**.

The Tour of Utah is a multi-stage professional bicycle race. Stage 3 of the race will be held in Davis County. This is the 4<sup>th</sup> year in a row that Davis County has been selected to be used as a stage. The race will start on Antelope Island, travel south through the county into North Salt Lake, then return northbound and end in Layton.

The race will enter Centerville southbound on Main Street from Farmington, turn right (west) onto Pages Lane (1000 South), then left (south) onto 200 West and on into Bountiful. When the race returns, it will come into the city westbound on Pages Lane from 400 East, turn right (north) onto Main Street. Main Street and Pages Lane will be shut down to all vehicle traffic about 10 minutes prior to the riders entering the city and remain shut down until the last support vehicle leaves. Roads will then be reopened until about 10 minutes prior to the riders returning through the city and then it will be shut down again. In years past, each closure has only lasted about 20 minutes, but due to many variables the closures could last longer.

We encourage residents to step outside on August 9<sup>th</sup> and watch this world class race pass through our city.
