- Closing Date:** A position for police officer is now open. The closing date will be November 10, 2018. The closing date may be extended depending on the quality and quantity of applicants.
- Starting Salary:** Competitive pay structure, wages are negotiable depending on qualifications and experience, credit will be given for related full-time law enforcement experience. Hiring incentive available in some cases. Minimum starting wage is \$20 per hour.

- Summary:** Performs law enforcement duties related to enforcing laws, maintaining peace, and protecting life and property. Patrols areas of Centerville City, responds to calls for service, controls traffic, writes reports, transports prisoners, represents a positive image to the public at all times, serves legal notices, summons, and warrants as required, attends wide variety of training to include proficiency in firearms and driving tactics. Will submit to a psychological evaluation and drug test.

Minimum Requirements: Must be 21 years old, no disqualifying criminal records, maintain certifications, graduate from high school, P.O.S.T. Certified / or the ability to obtain Utah POST Basic Certificate and be able to pass the URMMA Physical Fitness Standards Test, have a current valid Utah driver's license, and demonstrate good moral character, good communication skills, free of emotional, physical, mental conditions that might adversely affect the performance of duty as a police officer.
