20 **MINUTES REVIEW AND APPROVAL**

22 Minutes of the August 21, 2018 meeting were reviewed. Brian Plummer made a **motion**
23 to approve the minutes as written. Greg Call seconded the motion, which passed by unanimous
24 vote (4-0).

26 **HISTORIC HOME WALKING TOUR**

28 The Commission discussed the Historic Home Walking Tour that was held on September
29 8th. There were 48 tickets that were sold, and the Commission agreed the tour was a success.

31 **SIGN AND FUNDRAISING**

33 Cassie Younger, Assistant Planner, said there is \$250 in the GoFundMe Account, and
34 \$250 was raised from the sale of tickets for the Historic Home Walking Tour.

36 At 7:20 p.m., City Council Liaison, Stephanie Ivie, arrived at the meeting.

38 The Commission discussed possible fundraisers that could be held to raise more money
39 for the Deuel Creek Historic District Sign. After discussion, the Commission agreed a dinner
40 with a speaker will be tentatively planned for early 2019. Money that is left over from the budget
41 at the end of the fiscal can be applied towards the sign.

1 **CLG GRANT**

3 Cassie Younger reported the CLG grant money must be spent by August 2019. Proposals
4 for the grant will be sent out in the winter. Decisions will then be made on what homes will be
5 researched to see if they qualify for the National Historic Register.

7 **MISCELLANEOUS**

9 Jeanne Randall reported the Frankie Randall home located at 400 East and Porter Lane
10 had a fire recently, but most of the damage was caused by smoke. Jeanne believes there are funds
11 available for homes on the National Historic Register that are damaged, and she will verify if
12 funds are available for this home.


14 There will be members of the Commission whose terms will be ending in the near future.
